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Introduction

The Central Library and Documentation Center of Sharif University of Technology is one of Iran's leading academic libraries in science, engineering, and technology. Established in 1966, alongside the university's founding, the library has played a vital role in supporting education, research, and innovation for nearly six decades.

Today, the Central Library is located in the Dr. Mojtahedi Building on the campus's northern side. The library occupies approximately 6,000 square meters across six floors and provides a wide range of facilities and services for students, faculty members, researchers, and visitors.



The library includes the following service sections:

- Membership Unit
- Information Services and Document Delivery Unit
- Thesis Reading Unit
- Circulation Section (located on two floors)
- Periodicals Section
- Acquisitions & Knowledge Organization Unit (Cataloging & Classification & Indexing)
- Document Center

These departments acquire, organize, and provide access to books, journals, theses and dissertations, electronic databases, and other scholarly resources while delivering comprehensive library and information services to the university community.

In addition, the library offers six reading halls that provide quiet and comfortable spaces for individual study and academic work.

Need help finding information, conducting a literature review, or using academic databases? Our librarians are ready to guide you through the process.

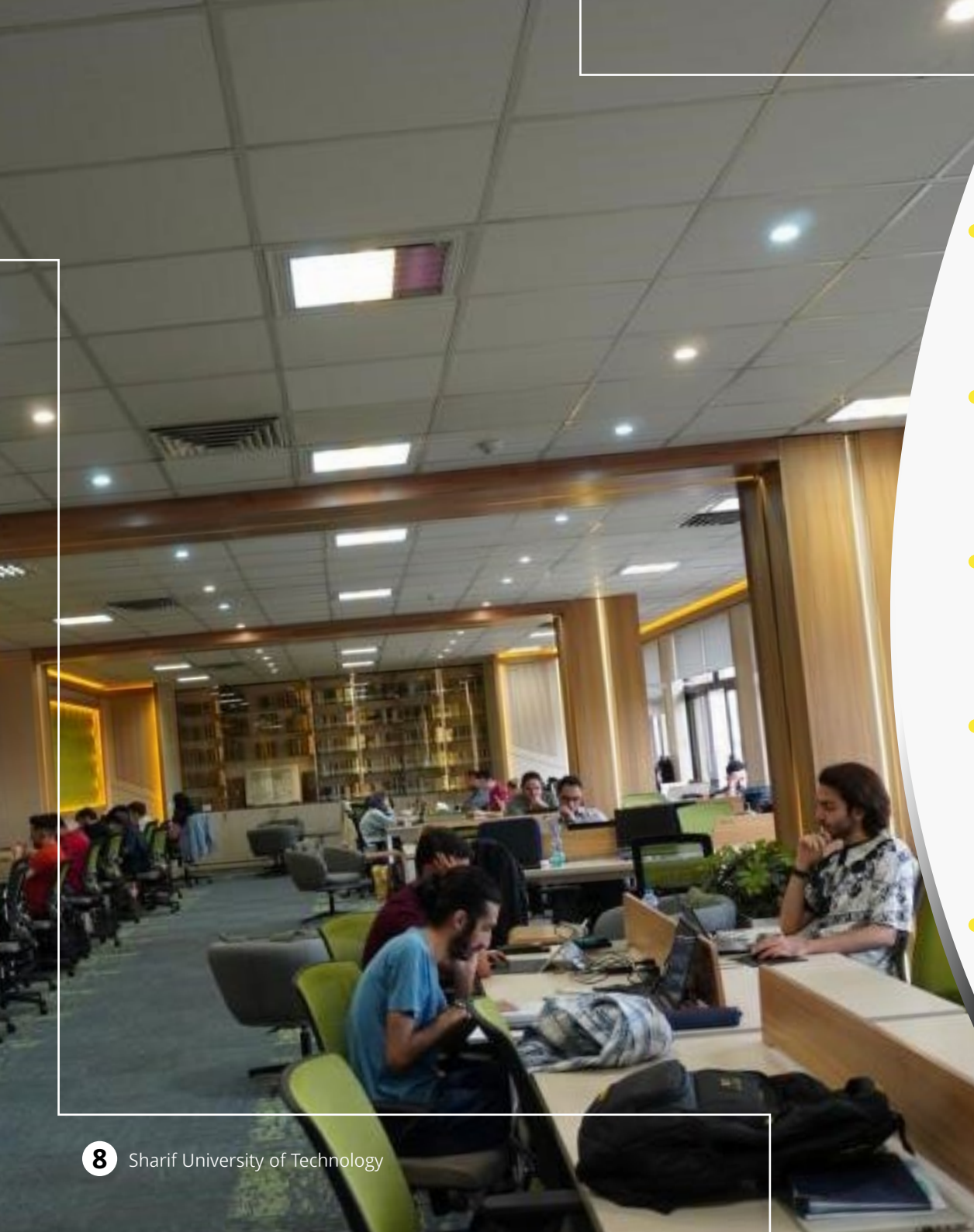
Access Trusted Scientific Databases

Library Services for Students

How to Become a Library Member

To become a member of the Sharif University of Technology Library, first visit the Library website at <https://www.sharif.ir/web/library/>. On the homepage, select the "Services" option, complete the online membership application form, and submit it.

To activate and verify your membership, you must visit the Central Library in person with your student ID. Membership verification is conducted on the Ground Floor of the Central Library.

You can do this with your account

- Borrow library materials
- Renew your loans online
- View your borrowing history
- Study Electronic books
- Study theses
- Access subscribed electronic resources

How to Search the Library Catalog

To search the Sharif University of Technology Library collections, visit the Library website at <https://www.sharif.ir/web/library/> and select "Search Library Resources" from the main menu.

You may choose from Quick, Basic, or Advanced Search, depending on your search needs. These search options allow users to search across all library collections simultaneously or within a specific collection.

To locate a particular item, such as a Persian or English-language book, perform your search and click on the relevant record in the search results. The

bibliographic record provides detailed information, including an item's availability and current circulation status.

Before visiting the library, note the book's Library of Congress (LC) Call Number and location code. You can then retrieve or borrow the item from the appropriate library, including the Central Library (First and Second Floors) or the Physics, Mathematics, and Industrial Engineering Libraries.

Within the Central Library, books with LC call numbers QD-Z are shelved on the First Floor, whereas books with call numbers A-QC are located on the Second Floor.

Borrowing and Renewing Library Materials

Each library member can borrow up to five books at a time for a loan period of 15 days.

Borrowed items can be renewed remotely through the Library's online system using the username and password provided at the time of membership registration, subject to the Library's circulation policies.

Connect to Library Wi-Fi

Free wireless Internet is available throughout the library.

Simply connect to the university Wi-Fi network using your university username and password to access the internet.
